- *Microtonal String Pedagogy* combining ear-training research and sequenced hand frames to achieve auralization and audiation of new intervals for my doctoral project. Presents the intervals of the neutral second, plus second, and neutral third through the idiom of Persian classical music.
- *Theory of Persian Classical Music* specialist studying the intervallic exigencies of Persian Dastgāh music, resulting in the creation of a novel solmization system for Persian classical music. Peer-reviewed scholarship that uses Persian modes in contemporary composition for the Journal of Artistic Research.
- *Composition of a Yiddish Song Cycle* as a recipient of the Joan Frazer Memorial Award for Judaism and the Arts. Written for mezzo-soprano and viola, the work sets 20th-century Yiddish poetry to give voice to a literary tradition cut short and marginalized by the loss of most of its native speakers.
- *Contemporary Technique Guides* developing a system for contemporary improvisation and advanced intonation studies for violin and viola, and extended hand frame etudes for violin. Also developing a technique guide specific to the challenges of Bartók's 2nd Violin Concerto.
- *Music Semiotics, Metaphor & Narrative Theory*, exploring how musical structures convey meaning through symbols, metaphors and narratives with comparative analyses with literary and visual mediums.
- *French & Italian Fluency, Spanish Proficiency* through Test for Evaluating French Access to Quebec (B2), McGill University in conjunction with the University of Milano, Spanish approx. B1 speaking and writing, respectively.
