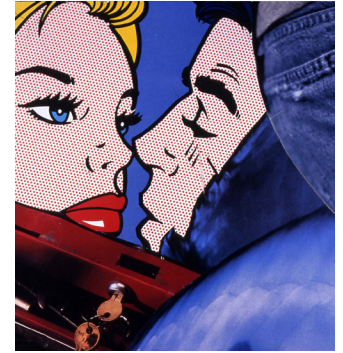
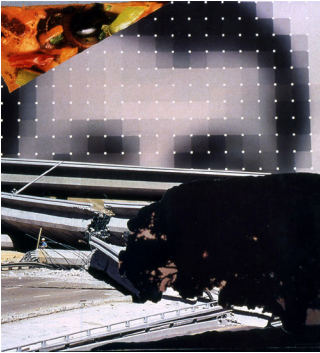

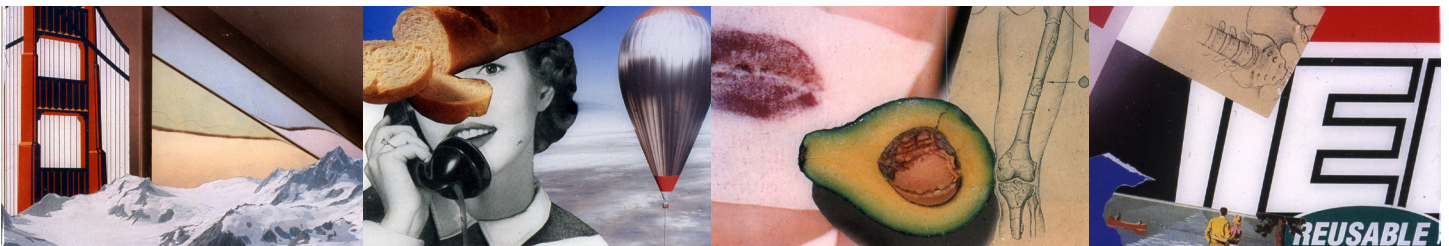

1. Images should be JPEG files at no less than 72 dpi
2. Videos uploaded to Vimeo or YouTube with link included in image list
3. All images should be numbered to correspond with image list (list format: title, medium, dimensions, and date)
4. Include no other information in pdf besides application material
